

<b>Coyote Backbone Trail Ultra</b>	<b>2017 - Version 8.0</b>	<b>BBT</b>
To / Next landmark	Instructions	Mile
<b>Will Rogers State Park</b>		<b>0</b>
	Right side of first parking lot along White Fence	
	Take Switchbacks and Merge with dirt road, follow road to where Backbone trail formally begins	
	Take trail up and left at the BBT sign	
	Cross Bridge	
	Continue up Single track	
	Follow signs to BBT on left going uphill	
	Merge with dirt road go right	
	Stay on dirt road and do not take side intersecting dirt roads	
	Arrive at the Hub with Kiosk and Bathroom	
	Take left up dirt road (not down and not straight), take the high road	
	At Eagle Rock The views are great, worth the 5 minute detour out and back (it will be south of the trail)...will be on your left	
	Continue down hill to Musch Trail and go right	
	Water fountain and bathrooms at Musch Camp, cross paved road	
	Continue on winding single track and then through grassy meadow	
	Water fountain at junction of paved road.. Go left	
	continue on paved road and go past the end of the fence line to gully with oak trees	
<b>Trippet Ranch</b>	<b>Arrive at Trippet Ranch Aid Station</b>	<b>12</b>
	Return back to end of fence line and turn left on Dead Horse trail	
	Continue on Deadhorse trail following course markings	
	Arrive at Dead horse parking lot.. Bathrooms will be locked.	
	Continue past bathrooms keep them on your left and head down hill single track to Topanga Canyon	
	<b>WATCH OUT FOR CARS</b>	
	Cross Topanga Canyon veering left to Greenleaf Canyon Rd	
	Right on Greenleaf Canyon Rd cross bridge over creek and make immediate left 50 yards	
	Left on BBT uphill on narrow poison oak lined single track	
	Veer right as you proceed uphill	
	Trail levels out meeting old dirt road cut, go left down hill	
	At bottom of trail it meets the school property, make sharp hairpin turn right	
	Proceed past water tanks and keep them on your left to narrow single track	
	Follow single track to bottom where it meets Old Topanga Canyon Road	
	<b>WATCH OUT FOR CARS</b>	
	Cross Old Topanga Canyon veering right to BBT trail sign	
	Cross Old Topanga Creek	
	Proceed on old road cuts and single track	
	Long uphill through chaparell and oak woodland	
	At trail junction just before a road make a sharp hairpin right	
	Continue on Fossil Ridge on single track to a paved road and go left	
<b>Stunt Road Aid Station</b>	<b>Stunt Schuren aid station</b>	<b>18.3</b>
	Head down diectly Stunt Road and go up the hill to the BBT trail	
	Continue up single track to a paved road leading to water tower	
	pass water tower keeping it on your right	
	Pick up single track uphill to junction of Saddle Peak trail go right	
	Follow rocky single track downhill keeping left at junctions (do not go to Stunt Road that parallels the trail)	
	Cross creek at bottom of switch backs	
	Single track meets Piuma Road	
	<b>WATCH OUT FOR CARS</b>	<b>22.7</b>
	Cross Piuma Road and continue on single track	
	Trail will go past a few homes with Wildlife Rescue and Raptor Rehab Avirary cages on your right	
	Cross Creek and meet Piuma Road, go left running on dirt shoulder	
<b>Piuma Aid Station</b>	<b>Meet Las Virgenes, Malibu Canyon road, Cross at designated location manned by CHP and go left following road to Las Virgenes, to Piuma Aid Station</b>	<b>25.6</b>
	From Piuma Aid Station head uphill passing bathroom on you left	
	Sharp left up hill to single track old road cut Right (Mesa Peak Motorway)	
	Continue up a long climb to veering right at junctions to top of hill	
	Continue to single track and climb "a backbone of sandstone slabs" to the top of the rock and go left	
	Continue down single track to Corral Canyon Aid Station	
	<b>Corral Canyon Aid Station</b>	<b>31.6</b>
	Head down single track crossing creeks (dry) and then climb out to a dirt road at a saddle	
	Go right at the saddle picking up single track on the other side left	
	<b>Continue on single track, crossing creeks crossing over one paved road (Latigo Cyn) WATCH FOR CARS</b>	<b>34.9</b>
	Continue on singletrack crossing over Kanan Road Tunnel and then down to the Kanan Road MINIMAL water only Aid station	
	<b>Kanan Road (Water only)</b>	<b>38.1</b>
	Continue on single track keeping left, cross two bridges and continue on single track	
	Meet dirt road at Zuma Ridge and go left up hill until a faint singletrack is on your right where the road make a left heading uphill	
	Take single track up hill meeting dirt roads, follow trail marking crossing a bridge at the bottom of a hill	
	Continue on single track, crossing a second bridge to meet Encinal Canyon Raod	
	<b>WATCH OUT FOR CARS</b>	
<b>Encinal Aid Station</b>	<b>Cross Encinal Canyon road to arrive at Aid Station</b>	<b>42.4</b>
	Follow connector trail to Mulholland Highway	
	<b>WATCH OUT FOR CARS</b>	<b>43</b>
	Cross Mulholland Highway and follow trail up switchbacks to Etz Malloy Motorway make left turn up hill	
	Continue on Etz Malloy Motorway to the Trail on the left BEFORE the gates, follow this trail to the road	
	<b>WATCH OUT FOR CARS</b>	<b>47.5</b>
	Cross Yerba Buena Road veering left on the road for 10 yards until you see a trail on the right	
	Proceed up the Backbone Trail as it follows contours with great views of the ocean	
	Follow this trail to a saddle and then you will see the aid station in the distance below	
	Stay on single track, do not go on the road and climb up the the aid station at Misha Mokwa trail	
<b>Misha Mokwa Trail</b>	<b>Misha Mokwa Aid station</b>	<b>52.9</b>
